- Staff 7: C, D, D \flat , E, E \sharp , F
- Staff 8: F, G, G \flat , A, A \sharp , B
- Staff 9: B, C, C \sharp , D, D \flat , E
- Staff 10: E, F, F \sharp , G, G \flat , A
